The ReSupportMi e-tool is set up and ready for both of the project' target groups, refugees/migrants and adult educators, validating the added value that has brought to the project. The e-tool is available in all partners' language, English, Greek, French, and Italian and in Arabic and Farsi.

Additionally, ReSupport-Mi e-tool is freely open to everyone to register in the Capacity Building Courses and the Intercultural Communication Webinars for the next 3 years. In the same context, the Certification in becoming Certified Trainer in Intercultural Communication will be free for the next 3 years after the completion of the project.
