ETRe Project 4th Transnational Project Meeting

The project: "Empowering schools' transition readiness to a distance/hybrid learning model enhanced by cloud technology tools"-(ETRe), is funded by the European Commission under ERASMUS+ KA2 Programme. The project, is addressed to educators, educational organizations, decision makers, and school principals, aiming to:

- create a framework of digital competences and a set of the characteristics of an educational digital tools repository,
- explore the importance and the add-on value of the available open source tools,
- empower educators by offering a set of easy-to-read information for tools,
- develop a guide on how to adapt the suggested framework within a classroom
- **develop a distance/hybrid learning certification** process for a school organisation to set a standard for schools that wish to achieve an adequate level of readiness.

The RESULTS of PATHWAYS project "Upskilling by Creating individualized Learning Pathways" is completed

The final Conference of the above project took place in Nicosia, Cyprus on Thursday 19 January 2023. The project created a methodology and a set of tools for adult educators and career professional through which they will be in the position to guide low skilled adults in having basic skills acquired through non-formal or informal recognized learning.

The "Pathways" delivered the following outputs:

- The Pathways toolkit for adult education and career professionals who work with unemployed low skill adults
- The training course addressed to adult education and career professionals, aimed at building their capacities to implement the Pathways methodology
- The Pathways e-Learning platform, which will be facilitating the results of the project
