Erasmus+ 2023 call launched: 4.2 billion euro to support mobility and cooperation in education, training, youth and sport

Today (23 November 2022), the Commission launched the call for proposals for 2023 under the Erasmus+ programme. With an annual budget of €4.2 billion, Erasmus+ is increasing its support for inclusion, active citizenship and democratic participation, and green and digital transformations in the EU and internationally.

The programme will rise to the challenges we expect to face in 2023 by providing meaningful support to learners and educational staff fleeing the war in Ukraine, continuing to strive for a more inclusive programme, and building on the legacy of the [European Year of Youth](#).

The entire Erasmus+ programme focuses on four [key priorities](#), among which, inclusion and diversity. Organisations and participants with fewer opportunities themselves are at the heart of this priority. The

programme therefore keeps on supporting participants' inclusion mechanisms and dedicated resources to remove any barriers to their participation.

Latest Erasmus Without Paper assessment shows EWP works but some connections have problems

The recently published Erasmus Without Paper assessment report made clear that EWP works. However, some software providers do not yet fully comply with the EWP standards. As a result, data exchanges are not always successful, especially regarding inter-institutional agreements.

REVEALING - EAEC project

The first result of **REVEALING is the creation of a model of a Virtual Reality Learning Environment (VRLE)** tailored to HEI (higher education institution) education. The VRLE will take the form of 3D virtual classrooms, compliant with VRChat.

It will be made **accessible to instructors and students**, who will be enabled to co-exist **in a shared virtual environment**, communicate with verbal and non-verbal means and engage in collaborative educational tasks.

PATHWAYS - EAC project

Pathways project aims to create a methodology and a set of tools for adult education and career professionals through which they will be in the position to guide low skilled adults in having basic skills acquired through not formal and informal RECOGNISED learning.

The project results developed so far are: the PATHWAYS Toolkit and the PATHWAYS Trainers Handbook and training course.

The [e-learning platform](#) of the PATHWAYS project is now available in English. Logging in, you will be able to go through the course that the partnership has created, read the materials, take small quizzes to test your knowledge, and get a final badge once all the modules are completed!

The PATHWAYS project is entering its final phase and on the 19th of January the partnership will gather for the final conference in Nicosia, Cyprus. This conference will bring together the whole range of project stakeholders and will inform them about the project outputs and the lessons learned. Experiences from the pilot phase will be shared and members of the target group and final beneficiaries will be asked to share their experience. The conference is open to 10 international participants!
